The City of Miami's Programs for Persons with Disabilities

Sandra DeLuca Developmental Center is managed by the City of Miami, Department of Parks and Recreation and was established in 1973 to foster and develop a more comprehensive community based recreation program capable of assimilating people with disabilities into the mainstream of the community.

The program's mission is to provide persons with disabilities equal access to leisure, educational and cultural opportunities while enhancing their quality of life and inspiring confidence, self-esteem and knowledge to live independently.

The annual City of Miami Golf Classic has raised over \$550,000 for the Sandra DeLuca Developmental Center, providing hurricane shutters, furniture, office furniture, equipment, appliances, fixtures for the center, as well as the purchase of wheelchair minivans and buses for use in transporting its program members to and from the many events and social functions conducted by the center throughout the year and has provided entertainment and refreshments for these occasions.

The Sandra DeLuca Developmental Center is a multi-purpose, fully accessible building and playground at Kinloch Park, 4560 N.W. 4th Terrace. This facility houses our staff, programs, camps and special events. Current fundraising projects are focused continuing to support various programs.

Dade Amateur Golf Association

The Dade Amateur Golf Association ("DAGA") was founded in 1963. DAGA has been instrumental in the continuing development of junior golf in South Florida.

In 1968, we started the junior league. It was formed like the Kory baseball league. We got the assistant pros at each club to get junior teams and they then competed against each other. Thirteen matches were played on Monday's throughout the summer months.

In the early 70's and 80's, DAGA ran tournaments in Dade, Broward and Palm Beach Counties along with Skipper Chuck for Jerry's Kids. We raised over \$60,000 for Jerry's Kids. It was kids raising thousands of dollars in each County with the monies going to the Muscular Dystrophy Telethon. We had some of our kids man the phones during the televised Telethon.

In 1994, DAGA got involved with the City of Miami which benefits Programs for Persons with Disabilities. We purchased wheelchairs, buses, vans, furnishings for the Sandra DeLuca Developmental Center and paid for various programs.

In December 2002, the Dade Amateur Golf Association was privileged to become part of the First Tee Network. We are now known as The First Tee Miami-Dade Amateur Golf Association.
