Races close in Doral Junior golf

Sean Kelly of Bradenton and Laetitia Beck of Israel hold slim leads after the second round of the Doral Publix Junior Classic on Tuesday.

Kelly leads Chile's Cristobal Del Solar by a stroke in the boys' 16-18 division.

Beck leads Camilla Hedberg Bertrand of Spain by two shots in the girls' 16-18 division.

Kelly shot a 1-under-par 69 and is at 2-under 138. Daniel Berger of Jupiter is third at even par.

Chad Stumpo of Massachusetts overcame a wrist injury to make a hole-in-one on the 11th hole.

“I thought it was going to be really close, but I didn't actually think it was going to go in,” Stumpo said. “The next thing I know, it disappeared into the hole.”

Beck shot a 2-under 70 and is at 5-under 139. She said she is trying not to think about leading the field entering the final round.

She added that attacking the pin and hitting her greens will be crucial to maintain her lead.

In the boys' 14-15 division, Denmark's Frederik Hammer shot a 2-under 68 and is at 8-under 140, two shots ahead of Austria's Matthias Schwab and France's Kenny Subregis.

Delfina Acosta led the girls' 14-15 division for the second day in a row.

She shot a 2-under 68 on Tuesday, and is at 2-under 138, five shots ahead of Denmark's Daisy Nielsen.

Play resumes at 7:30 a.m. Wednesday. All but the girls' 14-15 division will feature a consolation round, in addition to the championship flight.
