Cocha, Beck win titles at Doral Jr.

Tommy Cocha of Argentina and Laetitia Beck of Israel took different paths to titles at the Doral Publix Junior Classic on Wednesday.

In fourth place entering the final round, Cocha rallied with an even-par 72 to finish at 3-under 213 and win the boys' 16-18 division. Cocha finished a stroke ahead of Jupiter's Daniel Berger, and Belgium's Thomas Pieters was two strokes back.

"I was playing really good throughout the week, and I was feeling really confident in my game," Cocha said through a translator.

Beck was consistent throughout the event, shooting a 69 and two 70s in the 54-hole tournament. She finished at 7-under 209, five shots ahead of Camilla Hedberg Bertrand of Spain.

"[The strongest part of my game] was putting," Beck said. "[The wind] was tough, so I missed a couple of greens. But I was able to chip and putt."

In the boys' 14-15 division, Denmark's Frederik Hammer capped a remarkable performance by shooting a 4-under 66 to finish at 14-under 198. France's Kenny Subregis was second at 7-under.

"I find that the course fits me," Hammer said.

"If you're going to hit straight shots out there, it's pretty easy to find some birdies."

Delfina Acosta of Argentina won the girls' 14-15 title with a 1-under 211, five shots ahead of Finland's Anne Hakula.
